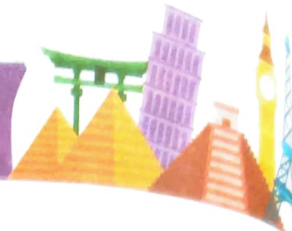

7. Name this sleek device that revolutionized the music industry. It has amazing storage capability, the largest model being able to hold more than 30,000 songs.

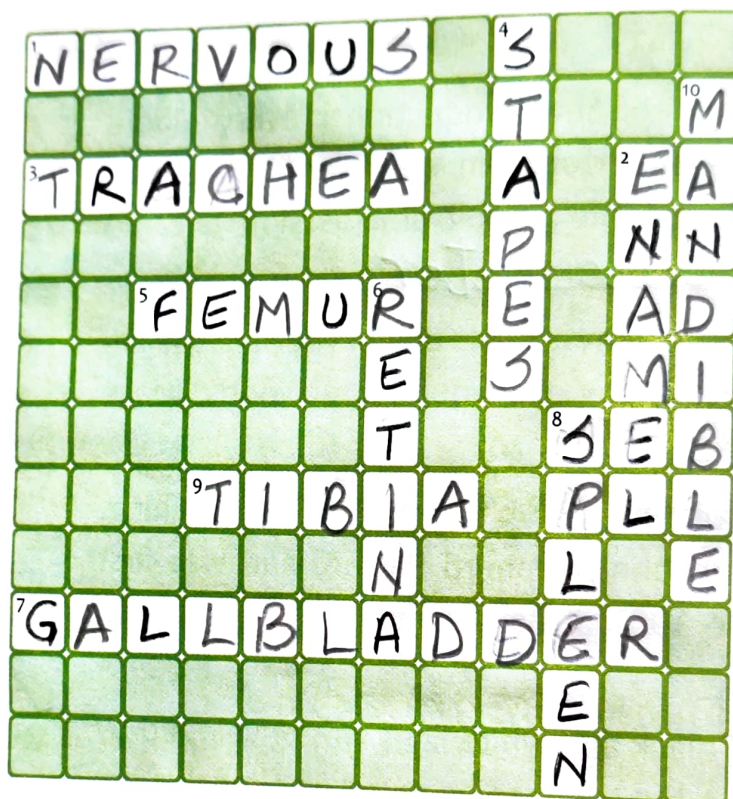

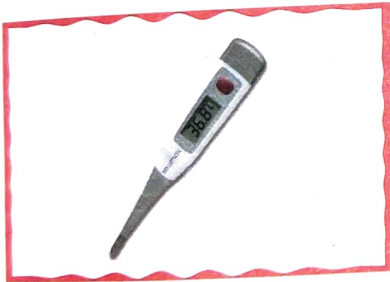

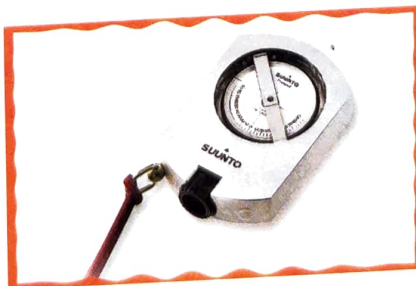
